



## Kindergarten Supply List 2008-2009

**\*\*\*Please bring all of your supplies to Meet Your Teacher\*\*\***

Below is a list of items that will help us all have a good kindergarten year. Please keep this list and refer to it during the year.

1. **CRAYONS** - Your child will need a box of Crayola 16 large size crayons.
2. **ELMER'S GLUE** - Please send in one bottle of Elmer's white school glue (4 oz.) (No colored, washable or glitter )
3. **GLUE STICKS (2 large ones)**
4. **SCISSORS** - Your child will need a pair of blunt scissors. We recommend Fiskar, plastic handled (metal bladed).
5. **WASHABLE MARKERS** - Please send in one box of washable Crayola Classic Color markers.
6. **LIQUID SOAP (Antibacterial)** - Please send one bottle of liquid antibacterial soap to be shared with the class.
7. **BAND-AIDS - (BOYS ONLY)** - To be shared with the class
8. **BOX OF TISSUES - (GIRLS ONLY)** - To be shared with the class.
9. **BOTTLE OF ANTIBACTERIAL GEL** - To be shared with the class.
10. **1 pack (2 pencils) beginner pencils (fat), sharpened**
11. **Box of gallon-sized Ziploc bags— (BOYS ONLY)**
12. **Box of quart-sized Ziploc bags— (GIRLS ONLY)**
13. **One pair of computer headphones—** - To be used in the classroom and at computer lab.
14. **RED AND BLUE PLASTIC KINDERMAT** - that folds to around 12" x 20". Due to health reasons, we cannot accept towels or pillows. Mats can be purchased at any Wal-Mart. Please PRINT your child's name on both sides so they may read their name. Due to health dept. regulations, torn mats will be sent home to be replaced. In the past we have found that other types of mats come apart more easily.
15. **BABY WIPES** - Please send in one container. These are great for quick clean-ups.
16. **SCHOOL BOX** - Please send in a SMALL, flip-top plastic school box (approx. 8" in. X 5 in.)
17. **SNACKS** - The children will have a snack daily. Each child will need to bring a box of individually wrapped "healthy" snacks at the beginning of each month. They will be shared with the class (enough for 25 children). Please send in the first snack immediately. Please do not send cookies, chips or anything that would not be considered "healthy." We eat snack mid-morning.
18. **DONATIONS** - We would like to request a monthly donation of \$4.00 per child to cover the costs of cooking, arts, crafts, film development and special activities that are conducted weekly in the classroom. You may donate \$4.00 at the beginning of each month or \$40.00 for the entire year. We appreciate your support in this area.
